We are currently taking the following measures to ensure we are operating as safely as possible:

- Bus interiors are being cleaned daily -floors mopped, surfaces wiped with disinfectant, windows cleaned, MYKI equipment disinfected, drivers cabin disinfected
- Route service buses are being fumigated three times a week
- Drivers are strongly encouraged to ensure they are washing and disinfecting their hands, information is regularly provided and available for our drivers, ensure they minimise their exposure
- Customer information is provided on buses regarding passengers washing and disinfecting their hands and taking care to ensure they minimise their exposure
- Our management team is meeting regularly and ensuring we have the most current advice from government for passengers and staff
- Lost property will only be handled in our Morwell administration office. Moe and Traralgon depots will no longer handle lost property and have restricted public access

- Our depot cleaning has increased, and fumigation of brew rooms and office will be occurring weekly
